4 Principles for the Growth of High Point University.

- 1. Create Value
 - We will be the premier life-skills university
- 2. Interpret the Value
 - o Take the value and explain it in ways that it's valuable in people's lives
 - We assume that people understand the value, but they don't. We have to interpret it for them.
- 3. Remove the Irritants
 - Remove what irritates people
- 4. Add "Wow" to the Experience
 - You don't just see it, you feel it
 - Add a lasting, sustainable, spiritual experience
 - Commit to get rid of the "un-wow"s and enhance the "wow"s.

How do you define value?

- The first question is, "Given choices, why would someone accept what we offer?"
- Determine value based on people's fears, needs, goals, and aspirations
- Our job is to create capacity in others

What is your motivation?

- Energy Management
 - Energy is by-product of the fulfillment of your passion. What drives you is that which
 you believe is important to do. What drives you seeing the results.
 - Energy does not come from success or passion for success. Energy comes from significance – when we know that we are a vessel that is creating something significant.

What are your guiding values and principles?

- I need the presence of God in my life every day.
- Pray for God to give you wisdom and strength.









- Energy Management Energy is the driver of it all.
 - Take an hour and divide into 5 minute units. Give out your time wisley in 5 minute units.
 - Practical: Early to bed, early to rise. Take a walk every day. Have quiet time every morning.
 - Ask your team to keep emails to 6 points or less and listed in a way that answers can be yes, no, or let's talk next week.
 - Return every call and every message by sunset.
