THE HEART OF ARC

- ARC is an organization dedicated to planting life-giving churches all over the world.
- ARC has given away 78 million dollars to church plants with a 93% success rate.
- Based on the data, ARC has set a goal of having over 400 people on launch day, with at least 200 people at a critical mass level to have long-term success for that church plant.

KEYS TO CHURCH PLANT SUCCESS

- Everything rises and falls on leadership, so investing in leaders is critical.
- Start the Growth Track to serve your community even before Launch Sunday.
- ARC Coaching program with over 150 touchpoints
- Ministry is tough, so be sure you are in a community of believers who support each other!
