ABOUT VANCE

- Vance started his career at Google working in their machine learning department.
- He and his wife started looking for a church home but many of the churches they visited never reached back out to them after visiting.
 - This is a great reminder that it is important to be responsive to people visiting!
- He later was connected with a church planter and helped plant Vive Church.
- As Executive Pastor, a member expressed an issue while giving to their church.
- By addressing that issue, they created a platform to help make it easier for people to give.

REMOVING FRICTION FROM GENEROSITY

- Overflow is a system of generosity that allows churches to receive stock, cryptocurrency, and traditional forms of giving.
- The platform has facilitated over \$200 million in donations across 600 churches, supporting outreach and building projects.
- By removing friction from the giving process and ensuring clear communication, engagement, and generosity can significantly increase.
- Pastors should consider hiring technology experts to navigate and leverage modern tech for church growth.
