WRITING & BUILDING A CONTENT BANK

- Don't write out of pressure—write from conviction and margin.
- Create a daily writing rhythm, like 1,000 words/day, and stick to it.
- Track content ideas by theme or topic using systems like Evernote.
- Pay attention to how your body reacts to content—it often signals what's worth saving.
- Make notes for your future self after each series or project.

"When I feel a biological response, that's when I take note of something." - *Levi Lusko*

MIDLIFE MOMENTS & SPIRITUAL RESET

- Ministry burnout can hit during seasons of success—not just struggle.
- Panic attacks and loss can signal a need to recalibrate and rediscover calling.
- God often uses spirals to reset our pace, identity, and mission.
- Don't play hurt—heal, rest, and re-engage with a new mindset.
- Significance isn't about title or scale—it's about pouring into others.

"What becomes more significant is less just what you do and more what you can equip someone else to do." - *Levi Lusko*

REDEFINING LEGACY & THE SEASONS OF LEADERSHIP

- Seasons of Life
 - <u>Early life</u>: build the container.
 - <u>Midlife</u>: fill it with what matters.
 - <u>Final Season</u>: prepare to give the container and its contents away.
- Great leaders must shift from stage to sage—mentoring the next generation.
- Don't chase more—invest deeper. Let your ceiling become someone else's floor.

"What hit me was, 'If you can spiral down, why can't you spiral up?' " - Levi Lusko









MARRIAGE, MINISTRY, & INTENTIONAL CONNECTION

- Don't start date nights with check-ins—separate fun and feedback.
- Audit your marriage regularly: what coin (connection point) might be missing?
- Marriage is a reflection of God's covenant—protect it with joy and intentionality.
- Use rhythms like retreats, routines, and honest conversations to recalibrate.
- Spiritual leadership starts at home—build together, not just publicly.

"There's so many facets of our marriage: creativity, intimacy, generosity; all these different things that make a marriage strong." - *Levi Lusko*
